

## RAMSEY CANYON PRESERVE

### Directions

Take Highway 92 south from Sierra Vista for six miles and turn right on Ramsey Canyon Road. The preserve is at the end of Ramsey Canyon Road, four miles west of the highway.

There is room for a single coach back down Ramsey Canyon Road, at mile marker 1, on the left side of the road, on a small parcel of land owned by The Nature Conservancy. The Nature Conservancy has a small metal building on the property right next to the road. Occasionally, vehicles are parked there, but not often. If that space is taken, a coach driver would just need to continue down the road back toward Hwy 92 and search for a suitable location. There is a turn around large enough for a motor coach to drop off passengers and turn around toward Hwy 92 (Pictured below).
